

Assistant Professor of Mathematics

Position

- Tenure track teaching position in the Department of Mathematics
- Rank--assistant or associate professor-- will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Duties

- Duties include teaching undergraduate mathematics with a commitment to student learning. Course assignments range from freshman level liberal arts mathematics through senior level courses in the Bachelor of Science in Mathematics curriculum. The standard teaching load is 15 credit hours per semester with ten open-office hours per week.
- Participate in student advisement.
- Engage in professional development activities.
- Serve on departmental, school, and university committees.
- Actively serve the local community.

Qualifications

- Ph.D. in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics required. Preference will be given to applicants with areas of specialization that complement existing faculty.
- A record of research and publication are desirable.
- A record of administrative experience is desirable, but not essential.
- The candidate must be prepared to affirm and support the Christian and liberal arts mission of the university.
- U.S. citizenship is required.
