

# Instructor of Mathematics

## Position 1

- Non-tenure track teaching position in the Department of Mathematics
- Full-time, nine month, continuing position, beginning August 9, 2010

## Duties

- Primary duties are instruction of first-year college-level general-education mathematics and mathematics education courses.
- The full-time teaching load is 15 credit hours per semester. Applicants should be prepared to teach liberal studies mathematics courses and mathematics for teachers almost exclusively.
- Additional duties will include holding 10 office hours per week, mentoring at-risk students, participating in school or university committees, attending two faculty development activities/workshops per semester, and attending commencement activities.
- Teaching opportunities during the summer may be available depending on enrollment. Summer assignments are not guaranteed.

## Qualifications

- Applicants should have a masters degree in mathematics or mathematics education with at least 18 graduate hours in mathematics and 18 graduate hours in education.
- Applicant should have a strong commitment to teaching at a liberal arts school. Evidence of successful teaching at the college level is required. Bethune-Cookman University is specifically seeking instructors with experience teaching and mentoring both developmental and at-risk students.
- Evidence of experience with curriculum design is strongly preferred.
- Preference may be given to applicants with prior employment in a science related field outside of academics.
- The candidate must be prepared to support the Christian and liberal arts mission of Bethune-Cookman University.
- U.S. citizenship is required.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
