

School of Nursing Opportunities

Bethune-Cookman University invites applications for full and part-time nursing faculty for our traditional BSN program. The School of Nursing is on the campus which is located in Daytona Beach Florida and features clinical simulation and skills laboratories, comfortable classrooms, 300 seat lecture hall, 60 seat computer lab, and an integrated library, conducive to both group work and computerized learning.

We are particularly interested in faculty with academic preparation and clinical expertise in Adult Health, Pediatrics, Critical Care, and Obstetrics. Adjunct clinical instructors are also encouraged to apply, being responsible for clinical instruction in affiliated hospitals in Volusia and Flagler counties. These positions will be filled as they become available.

Qualifications – Faculty Members:

A master's degree in nursing is required; preference will be given to applicants with a doctorate in nursing or a related field. Eligible candidates must be licensed as an RN in Florida or eligible for licensure.

Qualifications – Clinical Instructors:

Applicants must be clinically competent in medical/surgical, mental health or other specialty areas (such as obstetrics, pediatrics, or geriatrics) and must have recently worked in a clinical environment. A baccalaureate degree in nursing and a Florida RN license are required; a master's degree is preferred.

All applicants must be able to use instructional technology, possess excellent written and oral communication skills, have effective management skills and be able to work a flexible schedule that occasionally may include evenings or weekends.
