- Advance student learning through dedicated, exemplary instruction in accordance with established course outlines and exit criteria.

### EDUCATION and EXPERIENCE:

- A Master's Degree in reading or education with at least 18 graduate credit hours in reading.
- Training and/or experience in teaching a range of college-preparatory and freshman-level reading courses.
- Successful, documented teaching experience at a secondary or college level.

### ENVIRONMENTAL/PHYSICAL CONDITIONS:

- Working environment is a normal business office setting.
- Must be mobile throughout the campus.
- Typically, the incumbent may sit comfortably to do the work. However, there may be some walking, standing, bending, or carrying of light items.
